

Rebates will be issued only for NEW furnaces that are at least 40,000 BTU and Energy Star rated. Boilers are considered a water heater. Only furnaces/heaters for heating a residence are eligible. Furnaces for commercial buildings, barns, garages, pool houses, sheds, etc. are not eligible for this rebate. Rebates will be paid until funds are depleted and will be granted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Submit this completed application with the required documentation to the Michigan Propane Commission to the address provided on page 2.
